

**CALL FOR ABSTRACTS**  
**2012 AACD PERIOPERATIVE LEADERSHIP SUMMIT**

You are invited to submit an abstract for a poster exhibit at the 2012 AACD Perioperative Leadership Summit which will be held March 9-11 at the Renaissance Pere Marquette Hotel in New Orleans. Your poster will be exhibited during the Friday afternoon, Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon sessions. We look forward to your participation.

Abstracts should cover one or more of the programs your institution has implemented to:

1. improve efficiency without compromising patient safety;
2. improve patient safety;
3. improve perioperative patient outcomes;
4. improve perioperative care or care process;
5. develop innovative strategies to improve perioperative care or efficiency.

Or ... Programs you have implemented to improve Perioperative Patient Safety, Outcome, Efficiency or Process.

Abstracts need only cover one of the topics stated above although you are free to include two or more of these topics if you desire. Also, please include in your abstract a discussion of the financial impact of the program(s).

**FORMAT**

Abstracts must be in WORD document format only. The type size should be 12-point in any font. Abstracts are limited to 5 pages in length. They should contain the following sections in sequence:

1. **Title:** The title should be brief and accurately reflect the content of the abstract and the poster. The title must be typed in UPPER CASE.
2. **Author(s):** Please use a new line to list the author(s) immediately after the title by first name(s), middle initial(s) and last name(s). Include the author(s)' degree(s) (e.g., MD, RN) and title(s), if applicable, telephone number(s) and e-mail address(s)
3. **Institution:** Please state the name and location of the institution which is the subject of the abstract.
4. **Description of Program:** Please describe the program(s) that addressed one or more of the topics stated above and which will be the subject of the poster exhibit. Please make sure the abstract covers the items that will be included in the poster exhibit. Do not use jargon and undefined abbreviations.
5. **Illustrations:** Any charts, graphs and pictures must be included in the abstract and not submitted separately.
6. **References:** Any references should be numbered in the order in which they appear in the abstract. The journal, volume and page number are required.

The deadline for abstract submissions is February 6, 2012. Please e-mail your abstract (as an attached WORD document) to Nicole Bradle at the AACD Office at [n.bradle@asahq.org](mailto:n.bradle@asahq.org).

Within one week after receiving an abstract, the AACD will inform the author(s) if it has been accepted for a poster exhibit at the Summit. Authors whose abstracts are accepted for a poster exhibit must pay the Summit registration fee and attend the Summit in order for their poster to be exhibited. If there are multiple authors, at least one of them must attend the Summit in order for their poster to be exhibited. All authors also must sign an agreement giving the AACD permission to post their abstracts on the AACD website. (Authors will be listed on this website section.)
